

# PREMIER INN SLOUGH



Sigmat were appointed by Bowmer & Kirkland to deliver the light gauge steel framing for the new Premier Inn in Slough. The scheme comprised of 5,690m<sup>2</sup> of Sigmat panels, 4.9 tonnes of hot rolled steel members, 18 flights of stairs and 9 half landings.

Sigmat also facilitated the craning in of 150 plasterboard packs and 127 bathroom pods, to allow follow on trades to commence at an earlier stage ensuring programme timelines were met.

The project is the sixth successful Premier Inn for Sigmat.
